

## Waterslide InkJet Decal Paper guide – clear/white

**Description:** Make your own non-fire decals using an inkjet printer and acrylic gloss sealer.

**Weight:** 170gsm

**Size:** A4 (210mm x 297mm)

**Colour:** Clear or White

### Steps for use

1. Create/edit images on your computer.
2. Print images to the decal paper (clear decal paper for use on light backgrounds/white decal paper for use on dark backgrounds) using an InkJet printer.
3. Spray acrylic gloss sealer (Crystal Kote Clear Gloss or similar) being sure to cover surface evenly without missing any part of the surface. (The ink used in InkJet printers is water based, if it comes in to contact with water, it will wash off. The acrylic sealer stops this from occurring)
4. Allow to dry for approx 1hr.
5. Cut out decal image to desired size and place in tepid water for 30-60 seconds. Remove from water and leave decal to one side to allow water to penetrate through the backing paper and wet the glue this allows the decal to slide from the backing paper.
6. When the glue has dissolved and the decals slides easily from the backing paper, apply the decal to the item which is to be decorated. Carefully position the decal and then proceed to remove water and air bubbles from below the surface gently working from the middle to the edge.
7. Allow to dry and then if desired, apply additional coats of clear gloss to further protect and increase the durability of the decal.
